INTRODUCTION

This report contains the income statement for the Papua New Guinea Christian Professionals Network 2022 Blue Print Fundraising dinner.

The fundraising dinner was hosted at Gateway Hotel on the 26th of November 2022 following a 1 day, two nights Conference. It was to raise K300,000 to support Papua New Guinea Christian Professionals Network Inc. run all its programs for 2023 financial year.

We have raised a total of K230,500 in cash, commitments, donations and credit. Cash sales and cash donations totaled K148,750 while Credit sales totaled K81,750. We have collected K20,000 from the credit sales already in January 2023.

Our total expenses totaled K79,824.44 Most of our expenses derived from Venue hire and food (K45,000). The other main expenses include (K9,207.50) paid to E-Products for all the Merchandise, gifts and all printings. The staff salaries and annual leave amount has not been included.

- Our Expense increased by 69.15%. The projected expense was K55,200 but the actual expense is more than K79,825.44. (Some items that caused the increased include accommodation and airfare tickets for honorary members, lunch with outside centers members, Newspaper publication to name the few)

- h) We were 19% short of the projected amount. We were supposed to raise K283,750 but we only raised K230,500.
